

## **BAY OF ISLANDS YACHT CLUB SAFETY PROCEDURES FOR COVID ALERT LEVEL 3**

To keep boating at the Bay of Islands Yacht Club safe during the COVID-19 pandemic the club reminds all members and guests of the following safety requirements in effect at the club:

### **PHYSICAL DISTANCING**

Maintain distancing. You must keep two (2) metres (78 inches) away from other people who are not part of your family/social “bubble”. If you must get closer than 2 metres then wear a non-medical face mask. This will help prevent transmission of the virus.

### **HYGIENE**

Wash your hands often, for at least 20 seconds.

### **CLUB BUILDING**

The club building is closed to members and the public except for access to the men’s and women’s washrooms.

### **WASHROOMS**

Only one person may occupy each washroom at a time. This means one person at a time in the women’s washroom and one person at a time in the men’s washroom. If the washroom you need to use is occupied, please wait outside the building until that washroom is free.

Sanitising wipes will be available in each washroom. After using the washroom please use sanitary wipes to clean the toilet/urinal flushing handle, the sink and the faucets. Put the used wipes in the trash can, **NOT IN THE TOILET.**

### **CLUB OFFICE**

Use of the club office is restricted to the use of officers/directors and employee(s) of the club only. Authorised users of the club office will maintain the 2 metre physical distancing or wear a non-medical mask.

### **IN CONCLUSION**

These rules and procedures may be inconvenient but they are in effect to protect club members, guests and the public from transmission of the COVID-19 virus. If people fail to observe these guidelines there is a high risk that the Newfoundland and Labrador public health authorities order the club closed.

With care and consideration we can all enjoy a summer boating season and keep safe.
